WE BELIEVE...

The Gospel of Jesus Christ →

1 Corinthians 15:1-4

“Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand, by which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you—unless you believed in vain. For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures”

- **The Bible:** Genesis to Revelation is the inspired Word of God given to mankind. (2 Timothy 3:15-17; 1 Peter 1:23)
- **The Eternal Godhead:** The Trinity (the one true God, as revealed in Scripture) - the Father, the Son & the Holy Spirit. (Matthew 28:19; Luke 3:22; 2 Corinthians 13:14)
- **The Fall of Mankind:** Through disobedience, mankind fell from innocence and goodness and was separated from God. Because of this, death—both physical and spiritual—entered the world. (Genesis 1:26-27, 2:17, 3:6; Romans 5:12-19)
- **God’s Plan of Redemption:** Restoring mankind’s relationship with God through Jesus Christ. (John 3:16-17; Romans 5:8, 6:23)
- Our **Repentance** of sin and **Acceptance** of Jesus as Savior are essential for salvation. (Romans 10:9-10; 1 John 1:9)
- **Salvation** is through God’s grace alone. (Ephesians 2:8)
- The **New Birth** or being **Born-Again** is available to all through Jesus Christ. (John 3:1-21; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Galatians 2:20)
- **Water Baptism and Holy Communion:** Holy ordinances of the Church. (Matthew 28:19; 1 Corinthians 11:24-26)
- **The Baptism with the Holy Spirit:** A work of Christ that empowers the believer for greater service. It is evidenced with power to be a witness for Jesus - Acts 1:8. (Acts 1 & 2, 8:14-25, 9:10-20, 10:44-48, 19:1-7; Luke 11:13)
- Believers are called to live a **Spirit-filled, Spirit-led Life.** (Ephesians 4:30-32)
- The Holy Spirit imparts supernatural **Fruit and Gifts** to believers. Produce fruit and Pursue gifts. (1 Corinthians 12-14; Galatians 5:22-23)
- **Divine Healing:** God gives healing in our spirit, soul and body. Healing the sick is part of the commission Jesus gave. (Isaiah 53:4-5; Matthew 8:16-17; Mark 16; James 5:14-16)
- **The Second Coming of Christ:** Our Blessed Hope. (Romans 8:23; 1 Corinthians 15:51-52; 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17)
- **The Church** is the **Body of Christ** on the earth made up of all Christians. **The Local Church:** The expression of Christ’s love to a particular region— a place to build relationships and a family for believers. All Christians should be a part of a local Church. (Acts 16:5; Hebrews 10:24-25)
- **The Last Judgment** —
Heaven: The ultimate reward of God’s grace.
Hell: The ultimate punishment for sinners. (2 Corinthians 5:10; John 14:1-3; Revelation 7:15-17, 20:10, 15)
- **Evangelism:** Obeying Jesus’ Great Commission. (Matthew 28:19-20; James 5:20)
- **Tithes & Offerings:** God’s plan of provision for the Church and blessing for believers. (Malachi 3:10; 1 Corinthians 9:7-14; 2 Corinthians 9:6-8)
